DIRECTIVES FOR URGENT COURT
FRIDAY 24 JULY 2020 FROM 16:00 to FRIDAY 31 JULY 2020

1. The matters will be dealt with by Molopa-Sethosa J and Neukircher J. The particulars of their secretaries are as follows:

2. The phone number for the Urgent Court after hours is: 065 859 4819. Please note that this number should not be used during office hours.
3. There will be no roll call on Tuesday, 28 July 2020.
4. Strict regard will be had to the rules of urgency.
5. If cases are not ready at time of filing at 12:00 on Thursday 23 July 2020, they will not be heard, unless there is good cause or exceptional circumstances.
6. All urgent applications must include the certificate of urgency failing which the matter will be struck off the roll.
7. No piece-meal filing of affidavits will be allowed.

8. All cases must be uploaded on CaseLines. If any problems are experienced the relevant judge's registrar may be contacted timeously.

9. A practice note must be filed on CaseLines setting out the following:
 - a. the grounds for urgency;
 - b. the nature of the application;
 - c. the estimated duration of the matter;
 - d. if there is non-compliance with the JP's directives issued for the lockdown period or the practice directives for urgent court, the reasons for such deviation;
 - e. contact details for the legal practitioners, which must include both cellphone numbers and email addresses;
 - f. whether the matter can be decided on the papers or whether a video conference is required.
 - g. if a hearing in open court is required, the reasons;
 - h. if the matter **is opposed**: concise heads of argument must be filed by both parties before 12:00 on Monday 27 July 2020;

10. If there is non-compliance with this practice directive the matter will be struck from the role, unless good cause is shown for non-compliance.
