DIRECTIVE TO ALL PARTIES & LEGAL REPRESENTATIVES:

1. Matters will be heard in virtually by way of video conferencing on MS Teams on the dates allocated on the roll, subject to such reallocations as may become necessary.
2. Parties must forthwith inform the judge's secretary of all settlements, postponements & removals to facilitate possible reallocations. Parties will be informed of any reallocations. Legal representatives must remain available for the week to appear when called upon and until their matter is finalised.
3. Parties must comply with paragraphs 2.1 to 2.16 of the Judge President's Directive 2 of 2020 dated 14 January 2020 and paragraphs 102 to 109 of the Judge President's Consolidated Directive dated 18 September 2020.
