

DIRECTIVE:

UNOPPOSED MOTIONS ALLOCATED TO THE HONOURABLE JUSTICE KROMHOUT AJ FOR 26 JANUARY 2021 AND 28 JANUARY 2021

The following directive will apply to the hearing of the above matters:

1. *In addition* to the provisions of the Judge President's Consolidated Directive, in each matter a draft order in MS Word format should be transmitted via email, together with the prescribed practice note, to the Acting Judge's secretary by no later than 16:00 one clear Court day before the day of hearing of the matter (in other words by 16:00 on Friday 22 January 2021 for the matters to be heard on Tuesday 26 January 2021.)
2. In each application for summary judgment (unopposed and opposed) concise heads of argument, directly addressing only the issues to be determined, should be prepared by the parties who will be appearing, served on the other side and transmitted via email to the Acting Judge's secretary by no later than 16:00 one clear Court day before the day of hearing of the matter.
3. All matters will be dealt with on MS Teams and there must be appearance in each matter, subject to par 4 below.
4. There are some matters in which an appearance may not be required. The parties in such matters will be advised that they need not appear prior to the day of the hearing of such matter(s).
5. Court will start at 10:00. A MS Teams link will be published beforehand. Practitioners are required to ensure that they successfully join the MS Teams hearing well before 10:00.
6. Should a matter become settled or if a matter is to be postponed or removed from the roll, the Acting Judge's secretary should immediately be notified via

email, which email should include an appropriate draft order.

7. In matters where the order *could* include a return date (provisional liquidation orders and the like), the applicant's attorney should timeously make arrangements to obtain an appropriate return date from the Registrar.
