PRACTICE DIRECTIVE: UNOPPOSED MOTIONS BEFORE THE HONOURABLE MADAM JUSTICE BAM J: 29 & 31 MAY – 02 JUNE 2023 – VIRTUAL via MICROSOFT TEAMS – COURT WILL START AT 10:00

The unopposed motions will be dealt with as follows:

- 1. All matters will be heard via **MICROSOFT TEAMS.**
- 2. The link will be sent to the Bar Associations for the attention of the Legal Practitioners (LPs).
- LPs are advised to be in attendance from 9h30 on all the above mentioned dates. We will start with:
 - Removals, postponements and settlements, following numbering;
 - The remainder of the matters will be called in order of seniority.
- 4. Papers are to be properly indexed and paginated with a Practice Note in line with the

latest Practice Directive, dated 11 June 2021. <u>If this is not done your matter will be</u> <u>struck from the roll.</u>

- 5. On the question of the Practice Note, a deficient Practice Note will be disregarded and your matter will still be removed. LPs are to refer to the Practice Manual and the Judge President's prevailing directives.
- 6. The Practice Note must indicate at least the following (to assist the Judge in her preparation):
 - 6.1 Particulars and contact details of the legal practitioners;
 - 6.2 Brief background, with the factual and legal issues identified;
 - 6.3 The nature of the relief sought, (not a regurgitation of the Notice of Motion);
 - 6.4 Submissions and legal authority, the party is relying on, at high level;
 - 6.5 Estimated time required for argument
- 7. Failure to file a Practice Note setting out all the above information paragraph by paragraph, may result in the application being struck off the roll and a punitive cost order be granted in appropriate cases.
- 8. LPs are to refrain from contacting the Judge directly, either by way of an email, WhatsApp or phone.
