IN RE: DIRECTIVE FOR THE URGENT COURT WEEK 3, TERM 1, 2024 BEFORE VAN DER SCHYFF J

- The senior judge is Davis J. All applications that have been enrolled by 12:00 on Thursday, 1 February 2024 (when the roll closed) and allocated to Van der Schyff J are indicated on the allocation roll *infra*.
- 2. If matters were not ripe for hearing when the roll closed, they will not be heard unless there is good cause or exceptional circumstances are shown.
- 3. Where a matter is allocated to a specific date and time by Van der Schyff J, an allocation does NOT mean that the matter is sufficiently urgent to be heard on the merits.
- 4. Judge Van der Schyff's matters will, during ordinary court hours, by default, be heard in open court. Applications heard outside of ordinary court hours will be heard either on a virtual platform or in physical court as arranged.
- In all matters (opposed and unopposed) <u>a Practice Note as well as Heads of</u> <u>Argument</u> must be served and filed by all parties concerned.
- 6. Failure to file Practice Note(s) and/or Heads of Argument timeously, will be an indication that there is no appearance for the party concerned and the application may either be struck off the roll or be dealt with in the absence of such party.
- 7. The **practice note** must indicate at least the following:

7.1 Particulars and **contact details** of the legal practitioners;

7.2 Nature of the relief sought (without referring to the notice of motion);

7.3 A brief summary of the factual as well as legal issues involved;

- 7.4 The main issues to be considered;
- 7.5 A brief summary of the urgency or absence thereof;

7.6 Whether there was **service by the sheriff**, and if not, why not (unopposed applications);

7.7 Estimated **duration**;

7.8 Whether the matter is **opposed or not**.

- 8. The <u>Practice Note, or a supplementary Practice Note</u> must be filed <u>by no</u> <u>later than Friday 02 February 2024 at 12h00 and the Heads of Argument</u> <u>by no later than Monday 05 February 2024 at 10:00</u>. The applicant must also set out the reasons, in the Heads of Argument, why the matter is so urgent that it must be heard during the week concerned, by referring to the evidence in the founding affidavit. In unopposed matters the applicant must also indicate, in the practice note, where in the court papers the <u>Sheriff's return of service</u> is to be found.
- **9.** Service of process in all urgent applications must comply with the Rules of Court. Deviations will only be condoned if good cause is shown. Where an agreement was reached by the respective parties' legal representatives to provide for the electronic exchange of papers, this must be specifically stated in the practice note.
- 10. <u>All new applications</u>, during court hours, must first be enrolled through the Registrar of the Urgent Court and brought to the attention of the senior judge's registrar. The senior judge will allocate new applications brought during court hours.

- 11. The Rules pertaining to urgency <u>will be strictly enforced</u>. There is a growing tendency <u>to abuse the urgent court in two ways</u>: <u>First</u>, to set matters down which are not ripe for hearing, not being urgent or where self-created urgency is applicable. <u>This will not be allowed</u>. <u>Second, the urgent court is not intended to hear complex factual and/or legal issues</u> scattered over hundreds of pages and which may take a long time to consider and finalise (when new matters may also be encountered on a daily basis in the urgent court). This will prevent other parties having their matters be adjudicated in time. <u>Such complex cases may be removed from the roll and the parties may be referred to the Deputy Judge president for a special court to be allocated at some time in future</u>
- 12. Only where applications were created on Court Online and the Caseline file is not populated with the documentation, a hardcopy of the papers filed of record must be delivered to Van der Schyff J's chambers by Friday 02 February 2024 at 11h00.
